

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- SKYCITY Festival of Poker Satellite Poker Tournaments will be held from 1 August to 16 September 2010. Winners of the Satellite Poker Tournaments will receive automatic entry into the SKYCITY Festival of Poker Main Event, Day 1, Flight 1, 12.15pm 15 September 2010. All entries won are non-negotiable and non-redeemable for cash. Entries won are transferable through the poker Manager, provided that players requesting a transfer must hold multiple entries and must retain at least one entry.
Unauthorised transfers will be considered a “no show”, but the relevant entry fees may be used to maintain the relevant prize structure. Any entries won from any SKYCITY Poker tournament or satellite events from any SKYCITY Poker tournament are only valid for the use of the Main Event Tournament or Satellite Tournaments that feed into the Main Event
 - The Main Event Tournament will take place over five days starting on Wednesday 15 September 2010 with the final day being held on Sunday 19 September 2010 (these dates may be subject to change).
 - There is a limit of 360 players per tournament or per section of a tournament. SKYCITY reserves the right to commence a tournament whether or not all positions are filled.
 - Registration is on a “first come, first in” basis.
 - Players may make multi entries and advance entries for the Satellite Tournaments.
 - A separate registration form must be completed for the Main Event Tournament.
 - Only one registration per player to the Main Event Tournament will be permitted.
 - Entries will only be valid on acceptance of full payment of registration fee and completion of the relevant registration form.
 - Players who are not present at the start of a tournament will forfeit the registration fee for that tournament.
 - As part of the first place prize, the winner of the Satellite Tournament will receive automatic entry into other Satellite Tournaments or the Main Event Tournament. Satellite winners must still register on the separate registration form used for the other Satellite Tournaments or the Main Event Tournament.
 - Entries won are non-refundable but are transferable should a player win more than one seat.
 - All SKYCITY Poker Tournaments are open to players 20 years of age and older. Photo ID with proof of age is required throughout the entirety of the tournament.
 - SKYCITY reserves the right to refuse the entry of any player into any tournament.
 - Entries not submitted in accordance with the Terms and Conditions of SKYCITY Poker Tournaments will automatically disqualify the entrant from the tournament to which the entry related.
 - By participating in any tournaments, players agree to the Tournament Rules and the New Zealand Gazetted Rules for Tournaments.
 - Players agree to allow SKYCITY the unconditional use of their name and likeness for promotions, media, advertising and announcements without compensation, consideration, notice, review or consent.
 - SKYCITY reserves the right to modify or cancel any tournament at any time, for any reason, subject to any applicable regulatory approval, provided that such modification shall not, as of the date of such modification, materially alter or change any player’s prize already awarded. Notice of any such modification is sufficient if posted at SKYCITY Auckland premises.
 - SKYCITY may disqualify any player from participating in any tournaments or receiving any prize based upon fraud, dishonesty, violation of tournament rules or other misconduct whether or not related to any SKYCITY tournament.
 - Players are responsible for complying with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements when participating in a tournament and/or while on SKYCITY Auckland premises.
 - SKYCITY is not liable for injuries or losses arising or resulting from participation in any tournaments and is not liable for any acts or omissions by employees, whether negligent or wilful, in the conduct of the event and is not liable in the event of any equipment or software malfunction.
 - SKYCITY is not responsible for lost, late, mutilated or illegible entries nor for electronic transmission errors or delays resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorised access or alterations of entry materials, or for technical, hardware, software, or telephone failures of any kind, lost or unavailable connections, fraud, incomplete, garbled, or delayed computer transmissions, whether caused by SKYCITY, users, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in any tournaments or by any technical or human error which may occur in the processing of submissions which may limit, restrict or prevent a player’s ability to participate in that event or tournament.
- PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEES AND NO-SHOW FEES**
- A registration fee secured with a credit card will be charged to that player’s credit card account at the time of registration.
 - If a player reserves space in a tournament and secures it with a credit card, but does not show or cancels his/her reservation at least 48 hours prior to the beginning of the tournament and SKYCITY Auckland is unable to fill their seat, their credit card shall be charged the registration fee, which will be forfeited as a no-show fee.
 - If a player reserves a space in a tournament and secures it with cash, but does not show or cancels his/her reservation at least 48 hours prior to the beginning of the tournament and SKYCITY Auckland is unable to fill their seat at the tournament, the prepaid registration fee shall be forfeited as a no-show fee.
 - No-show and cancellation fees may be used to maintain that tournament’s prize structure.
- CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS**
- To cancel a reservation, players must call the SKYCITY Auckland Poker Manager on (09) 363 7021.
 - Players who secure their reservations with credit cards or who have prepaid their entry fees in cash may be refunded provided they cancel their reservation at least 48 hours prior to the beginning of the tournament.
 - Participation in the SKYCITY Poker Tournaments confirms an entrant’s acceptance of the Terms and Conditions and to participate in any reasonable publicity that may be required by SKYCITY.
 - In the event of a dispute, the decision by the Tournament Director is final. No discussion will be entered into.
 - Subject to the New Zealand Gazetted Rules of Tournament Poker, SKYCITY reserves the right to alter any of these Terms or Conditions at anytime without notice
